KEY THINGS TO REMEMBER

DEPARTURE: LEAVING YOUR HOMETOWN AIRPORT

WHAT DO I NEED BEFORE GOING TO AIRPORT

- \rightarrow Passport/ID (have at least 2 extra copies)
- → Cell Phone (if you have one) and Summer Search Emergency Contact Card
- → Flight Itinerary (2 copies)
- → Carry-On Luggage
- \rightarrow Checked Bag (if you have one)
- → Spending Money






Check your flight status to confirm the gate number and that it's on time



Then follow signs for "All Gates" and go through security (family can't go past this point)






WHAT GOES IN YOUR CARRY-ON?

- → 3oz. Or less size of liquids/gels/creams that can fit in a Ziploc bag
- → A water bottle, with no water in it (you can fill it up once you get through security
- → Extra pair of underwear, tshirt, toothbrush (in case of delays)
- → Sweatshirt/warm layer in case its chilly
- → A book or something to do on the plane (there is usually no internet)
- → Wallet, passport/ID, phone (if you have it), copies of itinerary, any other important paperwork



Then enjoy your flight!




ARRIVAL DOMESTIC (IN USA)


Once your off the plane, follow signs to "Baggage Claim"



Find the right baggage claim by looking at the monitors and get your bag



Then pick up your checked bag



Repeat the process on your way home!

Same process when you fly back, just slightly different look.

Your program's travel instructions will tell you where to meet your trip instructors. Check with your mentor if you do not have this already.

ARRIVAL INTERNATIONAL


Once you're off the plane, follow signs to Baggage/Immigration/Customs



You'll then go through customs/immigration. There will be signs if you need to buy your visa



Go through until baggage claim, and then meet your program



DEPARTURE INTERNATIONAL

Same as departure in the USA

The only difference is, you will then go through immigration again, usually before or after security, before getting on your plane.

You'll basically get your stamp saying you left the country.

ARRIVAL BACK TO USA FROM INTERNATIONAL

Complete the Customs Declaration on the plane (they usually give you a copy on the plane)






Then pick up your checked bag



If transferring to another flight once back in US, follow signs to Connecting/Transfers, it not, exit




If transferring, you will then drop off your checked bag, and go through security again
